We invite you to take part in the International Scientific and Practical Conference "**Problems of the Identity of the Cultural Heritage of Ukraine in the Conditions of the Russian-Ukrainian War and in the Post-War Period**", which will **take place on May 25, 2023**, at the Research Institute of Ukrainian Studies of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine at the address: Kyiv, 18 Isaakiana Str.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF REPORT ABSTRACTS**

1. Abstracts of the report **up to 5 pages** are accepted for publication.
2. The report abstract should be prepared in Ukrainian or English in the following format: A4 with the help of the Microsoft Word editor. Fields - 2 cm on all sides. Font is Times New Roman. Size - 14 pt. Line spacing - 1,5. Paragraph indent - 1,5. Pages are not numbered.
3. The structure of the report:
  - surname and initials of the author, scientific degree, academic rank, position, institution, city, country (font - Times New Roman; size- 14 pt; line spacing – 1; alignment to the right);
  - abstract title (all capital letters; font - Times New Roman; bold; size- 14 pt; line spacing – 1; center alignment);
  - abstract (font - Times New Roman; size- 14 pt; line spacing – 1,5; alignment on width);
  - requirements to the abstract content: the relevance and significance of the problem for solving important scientific and practical problems, the main part with elements of scientific novelty, conclusions, and directions for further research of the problem;
  - references (font - Times New Roman; size 14 pt; line spacing – 1,5).
4. The list of references is at the end of the text in the original language. The sources used **are numbered in the order in which they are referred to in the text**. Links to the source and pages in it are written in square brackets in the text. References are made in accordance with DSTU 8302-2015 Bibliographic Reference.

The authors bear responsibility for the content of the abstract of the report. The organising committee decides on the publication of materials and reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not correspond to the topics of the conference, do not meet the requirements for design or editorial policy, or are received later than **May 20, 2023**.

The organizing committee may make editorial corrections or abbreviations in the text without the consent of the author.
